Phototrophic cells with well-developed theca. Cell body dorso-ventrally compressed with a median cingulum that is descending. Triangular epitheca. Epitheca with horn curved and bent to the right and hypotheca extended into two curved horns. Antapical horns open.

Size; 45-65 wide, 150-300 wide.

Distribution; Temperate parts of Atlantic Ocean, Barents Sea
